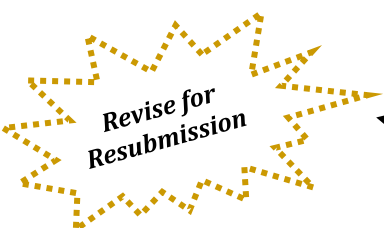

To meet the research needs of this rapid growth while operating under a limited budget, the Research Development (RD) team recently launched REACT.

The REACT program is unique because it uses existing resources to respond to the growing need for integrated support on large, complex proposal submissions.

When faculty need assistance on large, complex proposals, the RD team spearheads a multi-unit collaborative approach called REACT, an ad-hoc team that springs into action anytime a rapid, coordinated response is required.
